 <p>Q: <i>(in general)</i> <u>What's</u> this? <i>(person)</i> <u>Who's</u> this? <i>(place)</i> <u>Where's</u> this?</p> <p>A: This is a <u>picture</u> of an American Indian dancer.</p>	 <p>This is <u>another</u> photo of American Indian dancers.</p> <p><i>(at the moment in the photo)</i> Q: What <u>are</u> they <u>doing</u>? A: They're <u>dancing</u>.</p>	 <p>This photo has more dancers.</p> <p><i>(at the moment in the photo)</i> They're <u>dancing</u> in a circle.</p> <p><i>(general info, or to add more info than what is in the photo)</i> They often <u>dance</u> in a circle.</p>
 <p>Q: What's this?</p> <p>A: It's a drum.</p>	 <p><u>Here's another</u> picture of a drum.</p>	 <p><u>What you see</u> in this photo is Indian fry bread.</p> <p>It's made with flour, baking powder, and salt. It's fried in oil.</p> <p>People add different toppings. I put honey on mine.</p>
