What's the weather like?
Is it sunny in Tokyo?

It's sunny.
Yes, it is.
No, it's not. It's raining.

climate* = typical weather for area













Is it sunny or cloudy in Moscow?
Is it sunnier in Seattle or Los Angeles?
Is it the sunniest in Seattle, Los Angeles,
or Las Vegas?

It's cloudy.
It's sunnier in Los Angeles. (comparative, 2 things)

it's = it is; light – moderate - heavy

What's the temperature?

It's the sunniest in Las Vegas. (superlative, 3 or more things)
It's 68 degrees (Fahrenheit). (20 degrees Celsius/centigrade)

smog (smoke + fog) / It's smoggy. rain / It's rainy. It's raining right now. snowflake lightning and thunder cloud / It's cloudy. snow / It's snowy. It's snowing right now.	rainbow sun / It's sunny. smoke / It's smoky. mist (fine) - fog (thick) / It's foggy. wind / It's windy. hail (ice pellets) / It's hailing.
